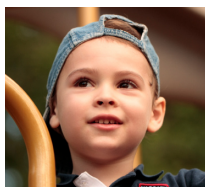


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Medicaid and Autism: New Therapy Benefits in Development



The Health Care Authority is developing a proposal that would extend an Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy benefit to all Apple Health for Kids clients with a diagnosis in the Autism Spectrum Disorder classification.

Pending federal approval, they will help families and providers arrange for these children to access the medically necessary services they may need. If you treat a child or are the parent of a child covered by Medicaid who has a diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder, and you believe the child is a candidate for ABA therapy or needs a consultation with a specialist, please contact Gail Kreiger at the Health Care Authority to learn about coverage pending federal approval or how to start this process. Free Orthodontic Treatment Opportunities Will Create Smiles all Around!



Dr. Haeger of Haeger Orthodontics in Kent has started a new chapter of *Smiles for a Lifetime* Foundation in our area. *Smiles for a Lifetime* is a non-profit organization which awards orthodontic scholarships to children whose families are unable to pay for braces. Dr. Haeger's goal is to improve the smile and self esteem of eight children a year by awarding them complimentary orthodontic treatment. Children who are good candidates are between the ages of 11 and 18, have orthodontic needs and would qualify for free or reduced lunch. Other circumstances such as a family with a large financial burden, due to other medical expenses, will be considered.

To nominate a child, contact Haeger Orthodontics at **253.850.7043** and request an application via email. The board will evaluate all applicants, selecting those with the greatest need: 100% of the orthodontic treatment costs will be covered by the scholarship. The application deadline for the first set of four recipients is March 31, 2013.
