



## **Top 10 Interesting Facts About the New Lobby Entrance and Surgery Center**

- ❑ The lobby encompasses nearly 20,000 square feet. Nearly all of this area used to be the exterior driveway entrance to the hospital.**
- ❑ The fountain in the lobby is 36 feet in diameter and will contain approximately 1,000 cubic feet of water, equal to 7,500 gallons or 60,000 pounds of water.**
- ❑ Windows across the front entrance extend 205 feet, with each of 33 panes measuring 10 by 5 feet. On the second level atrium, the glass windows cover 75 feet on each side, with each pane measuring 8 by 5 feet.**
- ❑ Nine skylights above the lobby atrium reach 34 feet 6 inches to their highest point. Each skylight measures 17 by 17 feet and is 9 feet 6 inches tall.**
- ❑ Including the front windows, atrium skylights and skylights above the corridors, the lobby contains a total of 7,400 square feet of glass.**
- ❑ Four columns hold up the lobby atrium 25 feet above the floor.**
- ❑ Each column is actually 37 feet high, as they extend below to the second floor.**
- ❑ The front driveway covers over 27,000 square feet with a total front door walkway of 180 feet.**
- ❑ The 10 new surgical suites are over 40% larger in total square footage than the previous operating rooms.**
- ❑ Each surgery suite range in size from 485 to 620 square feet. The smallest of the new surgery suites will be larger than the largest of the old operating rooms.**
