What are we doing

- > Establish care and follow ups patients who at high-risk for breast cancer
- Monitoring lung screening program
- Genetic counseling and testing
- Part of Breast Cancer Tumor Board
- Monitoring Incidental Finding Program



When to refer patient to the HRSG clinic

Personal or family history of:

- Breast cancer before age 50
- Colon cancer before age 50
- Endometrial cancer before age 50
- Ovarian cancer at any age
- Metastatic prostate cancer at any age
- Pancreatic cancer at any age

Patient does not NEED to meet criteria

- Adoption, unknown family history, anxious or curious about genetic risk
- Self pay testing is \$250



How to place a referral

- REF626 AMB REFERRAL TO HIGH-RISK GENETICS
 - Adult High-Risk [VMG]
 - NOT REF26- Prenatal/MFM, UW, SCH
- Please include types of cancer and ages of diagnosis, if possible
- We will triage if patient needs:
 - Genetic counseling/testing
 - ➤ High risk breast cancer screening and/or tamoxifen criteria



Cancer IQ screening at the Breast Center

- Cancer IQ = a patient portal that allows us to assess pts' personal risk of developing certain types of cancer and get personalized recommendations for prevention and screening.
- Evaluates for both:
 - High risk screening (>20% Tyrer Cuzick)
 - Genetic testing (NCCN)
- Patients are given this screening questionnaire at their mammogram
- ALSO screened via PenRad and TC% is listed on mammogram report
