Audiology Diagnostic Testing: Comprehensive Audiometry, Visual Reinforcement Audiometry, Conditioned Play Audiometry, Tympanometry, Patulous Eustachian Tube, Acoustic Reflex, Otoacoustic Emissions.

Audiology Conditions Evaluated and Services: presbycusis, unilateral and bilateral hearing disorders, sensorineural hearing loss, conductive hearing loss, mixed hearing loss, tinnitus, pulsatile tinnitus dizziness/vertigo, eustachian tube dysfunction; patulous eustachian tube, otitis media, ear pain, ear pressure, tympanic membrane perforation/rupture; otosclerosis, cholesteatoma and mastoid, hyperacusis, Meniere's disease, hearing aid candidacy, audiological counseling, and recommended treatment/care pathways with appropriate ENT referrals.

Other notes and minimum patient age (Audiology): Open to **Pediatrics Age 1-17 and adult patients.

** Pediatric restriction: Non-verbal and verbal patients uncooperative for otoscopy with Autism Spectrum (ASD) or suspected ASD, no history of OM and history of passing newborn hearing screening/ OAE at birth to be referred to Pediatric Audiology/ENT.

Advance work up:

General Surgery:

Diagnostic imaging available at consultation appointment is helpful. If imaging has not been done or is not available, the general surgeons will gladly discuss what workup is needed. We can be reached by phone or Epic message. For breast surgery referrals, patients need updated breast imaging (mammogram and/or ultrasound). For hernias, patients do not need imaging if the hernia is palpable on exam; if it is not detectable on exam then imaging to confirm the diagnosis of hernia is helpful.

Colorectal Surgery:

Staging for colon cancer, rectal cancer, anal cancer.

Other notes and minimum patient age:

General Surgery- We generally treat adults, but see patients as young as 10 years old, depending on the diagnosis.

Colorectal Surgery- Minimum patient age is 14.

Spirometry and oximetry testing are performed in the office. ABGs and PFTs are performed by the Cardiopulmonary Department. Referrals for tests and imaging will be received by the clinic but the patients will be contacted for scheduling by Cardiopulmonary Services or Nuclear Medicine.
