### TWO DAYS BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE

1. DRINK ONLY CLEAR LIQUIDS THE ENTIRE DAY: NO SOLID FOODS: NO MILK PRODUCTS OR NON-DAIRY CREAMER; NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

#### **APPROVED**

Beverages: tea, coffee, soda/carbonated beverages, fitness water, sports drinks

Fruit juices: apple, cran-apple, white grape,

lemonade (no pulp)

Desserts: flavored Jell-O, popsicles without pulp

Bouillon: clear, fat-free bouillon ONLY

Misc: salt, sugar



#### **AVOID**

No RED or PURPLE colors

No solid food

No milk products or

non-dairy creamer

No alcoholic beverages

No stock, broth, or soup

(store bought or homemade)

- 2. As a comfort measure, apply Vaseline, A&D ointment, or Desitin to the anal area before laxative use.
- 3. At 6 PM, mix the 4.1 oz. bottle of Miralax with 32 oz. of Gatorade. Drink an 8 oz. glass of the solution every 15 minutes until gone.



## THE DAY BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE

- 1. DRINK ONLY CLEAR LIQUIDS THE ENTIRE DAY: NO SOLID FOODS; NO MILK PRODUCTS OR NON-DAIRY CREAMER; NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
- 2. As a comfort measure, apply Vaseline, A&D ointment or Desitin to the anal area before laxative use. It is normal to pass yellow/green liquid stool after the prep.



**3. At 12 рм.** drink one 10 oz. bottle of Magnesium Citrate (Lemon-Lime). **Do NOT drink** if you have congestive heart failure or kidney/renal failure. You may mix it with Sprite, 7-up or ginger ale.



**4. At 3 pm,** take two 5 mg Dulcolax tablets with a glass of water.

# THE DAY BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE (continued)



5. At 5 PM, mix together the ENTIRE BOTTLE (8.3 oz./ 238 g) of Miralax with 64 oz. of chilled Gatorade.



6. Drink an 8 oz. glass of the Miralax solution every 15 minutes until you have finished drinking **HALF OF THE** MIXTURE (32 oz.).



**7. At 9 PM,** take two 5 mg Dulcolax tablets with a glass of water.

# **DAY OF PROCEDURE**



- (6 hours before your scheduled procedure), drink an 8 oz. glass of the Miralax solution every 15 minutes until you have finished drinking the LAST HALF OF THE MIXTURE (32 oz.).
- 2. CLEAR LIQUIDS ONLY UP TO 2 HOURS BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE TIME, THEN NOTHING BY MOUTH.
